LVHS Dance Team Expectations and Contract

All students who are selected for the LVHS Dance Team must have, maintain, and understand the following:

General Conduct

- Respect and Professionalism: Treat all team members, coaches, and others with respect. Avoid negative comments or behavior.
- Team Spirit: Maintain a positive attitude and support your teammates both on and off the dance floor.
- Punctuality: Arrive on time for all practices, performances, and events.
- Commitment: Follow through on your responsibilities and team obligations.
- Grades: Maintain a 2.0gpa or above at all times. Any students who fall below a 2.0 or have failing grades, will attend mandatory tutoring during Wildcat
 period and be placed on probation until grades improve.
- Turn in monthly progress reports
- Bad attitudes, rude behavior, and disrespect will not be tolerated. This will result in removal from the team.
- Represent LVHS in and out of school
- Not have any fines or referrals
- Be enrolled in a dance course.
- Always give 100% in rehearsal and performance. Dancers should rehearse how they will perform.

Attendance

- Mandatory Practices: Attend all scheduled practices unless excused by the coach in advance.
- Missing up to 3 rehearsals prior to a performance will result in removal from that performance.
- Notify in Advance: Inform the coach if you are unable to attend a practice, performance, or event.
- Performance Attendance: Be present for all scheduled performances unless there is an emergency or prior approval.

Practice Etiquette

- Preparation: Come to practice ready to work, with the appropriate attire, shoes, and any needed equipment.
- Focus: Minimize distractions during practice—no excessive talking, phones, or unnecessary breaks.
- Effort: Always give your best effort and actively participate in all activities.

Uniforms and Appearance

- Uniform Care: Keep all costumes, uniforms, and accessories in good condition. Wear them as instructed.
- Dress Code: Follow the dress code for practices and performances to ensure uniformity and professionalism.

Health and Safety

- Stay Healthy: Take care of your body by eating well, staying hydrated, and getting enough rest.
- Injury Reporting: Inform your coach about any injuries immediately and follow their recommendations.
- Warm-Up: Participate in all warm-ups and cool-downs to prevent injury.

Communication

- Respectful Feedback: Be open to receiving constructive criticism and offer feedback respectfully when appropriate.
- Team Communication: Keep up with team announcements and updates via group chats, emails, and remind
- Conflict Resolution: Address conflicts respectfully and promptly through proper channels
- Lack of communication will result in probationary action or removal from the team.

- Adaptability: Be ready to make last-minute adjustments if needed for performances or formations.
